

## Course No. 1

To secure the booking we require full payment within 21 days of making your booking after which the tee time will be released unless payment has been made. Any bookings made within 21 days of the date of play will be due payment in full at the time of booking. Payment can be made by cash, credit card or BACS payments. Credit only with prior written agreement.

Payments are not transferable between dates and courses.

Payments will be refunded in full, more than two months prior to the date of play. Within 2 months there will be no refund.

#### **Courtesy of the Course**

If your booking includes courtesy golf, this must be advised at the time of booking. Failure to make a request in advance of the date of play will result in the full green fees being charged. One round per calendar month. You must also bring your accreditation with you on the date of play.

#### **Vouchers**

If your booking includes a voucher, please bring it with you on the day. The voucher must be presented on the date of play.

#### Cancellations

We regret that we cannot offer refunds due to delayed/cancelled flights or travel plans, personal injury or illness. We recommend that you have travel insurance to cover this eventuality.

#### **Weather Conditions**

Only in the event that the course is closed on the date of play will the Club refund green fees or transfer them to another date. If a transfer is permitted, golf must be played before 31/12/24. (The courses do not normally close for windy conditions.

#### **Handicaps**

Visitors wishing to play No. 1 must provide evidence of handicap with a maximum for gentleman of 24 and for ladies of 30.

#### R&A

The R & A Rules of Golf plus published local rules should be observed.

#### Pairing Up

The Club reserves the right to pair visitors up in tee times without prior advice.

#### **Disclaimer**

The Club reserves the right to change the terms and conditions without prior notice.

#### **Time of Play**

The Club reserves the right on the day of play to adjust the time of play due to weather conditions, pace of play or situations outside the control of the Club. The Club will endeavor to keep the visitor updated with any changes.

## Courses No. 2 and No. 3

#### **Deposit**

A per person deposit must be paid to secure a booking. This is due to be paid within 7 days of making your booking after which the tee time will be released unless payment has been made. Payment can be made by cash, credit card or BACS payments. Credit only with prior written agreement. If paying by BACS all bank charges must be paid.

Deposits will be credited against green fees due in respect of all visitors playing.

Deposits are not transferable between dates and courses.

Twilight Rounds must be paid in full at the time of booking.

Deposits will be refunded in full more than two months prior to the date of play. Within 2 months there will be no refund.

Day tickets can only be reduced to single rounds more than 7 days prior to the date of play.

#### **Balance of Green Fees**

Green fees must be paid in full before play commences.

#### **Changes to Numbers**

For bookings of more than 1 tee time, final numbers must be confirmed 7 days prior to the date of play.

#### **Courtesy of the Course**

If your booking includes courtesy golf, this must be advised at the time of booking. Failure to make a request in advance of the date of play will result in the full green fees being charged. One round per calendar month. You must also bring your accreditation with you on the date of play.

#### **Vouchers**

#### **ARRIVAL & PARKING**

#### Course No. 1

Please park in the Members' Clubhouse Car Park situated on the left as you enter Gullane from the Edinburgh/Aberlady direction.

Once parked, please enter the Members' Clubhouse from the front where one of our reception team will be delighted to greet you, and answer any questions you may have.

We regard guests playing Gullane No.1 as 'Members for the day' so, like our Members do, please feel free to enjoy the Members' Clubhouse facilities including the restaurant and bar – we look forward to warmly welcoming you.

#### Courses No. 2 and No. 3

Please park in the Links Clubhouse Car Park situated on the right as you enter Gullane from Edinburgh/Aberlady direction.

#### **CHECK IN**

#### Course No. 1

Please check in at the Members' Clubhouse on your arrival, before going to the Starter 10 minutes prior to your tee-time.

#### Courses No. 2 and No. 3

Please check in at the Links Clubhouse on your arrival, before going to the Starter 10 minutes prior to your tee-time.

The Club has two Clubhouses. For visitors playing No. 1 please use the Members' Clubhouse and for visitors playing No. 2 and No. 3 please use the Links Clubhouse.

#### PRACTICE FACILITIES

Members and visitors playing the course that day are welcome to use the Club's practice facilities during their visit. Situated next to our refurbished Gullane Links Clubhouse (re-opened 31 May 2021), practice facilities include a Short Game Area to hone pitching and bunker shot skills, a Driving Range to test those longer drives, and two Putting Greens, one located within the practice area, with a second Putting Green located next to the 1st tee on Course No.1. Balls for the Range are included in the green fee. #### **GOLF PROTOCOL**

Slow play will not be tolerated. The Club supports the R&A guidance on the time that games should take: 2 ball - 3 hours 10 minutes; 3 ball - 3 hours 30 minutes; 4 ball - 3 hours 50 minutes. If you fall a hole behind the game in front, and are holding up those behind, you must call the following game through. Bag sharing is not permitted. Divots must be replaced, pitch marks repaired, and bunkers raked.

#### **TOILETS**

The Reception and Starters will advise of the location of the toilets on the courses when you check in. The codes to enter the buildings are on the scorecards.

#### **ALCOHOLIC DRINKS**

Alcoholic Drinks are not allowed on the courses. Any person found in possession of alcoholic drinks will be removed from the course.

#### **SECRETARIES/ORGANISERS**

Are responsible for the behaviour of their groups. Please ensure that your members are aware of the Club rules prior to play. The Club reserves the right to remove any person behaving in an inappropriate manner on the course or in the Clubhouses.

#### **LIABILITY**

Visitors, their vehicles and any clothing and equipment are on Club property at their own risk and the Club has no liability. The Club has the right to refuse entry or the removal of a visitor at its absolute discretion.

Golf has been played over the links at Gullane for more than 350 years. Today, Gullane Golf Club is one of Scotland's most prestigious member clubs, mixing the finest tradition with some of the most admired natural links land in the world.

Gullane is blessed with superb turf and a climate that allows all year round golf. Visitors are welcome to play our championship courses which offer dramatic coastal views and a golfing challenge to savour.

Laid out over prime seaside land, the three golf courses are simply known by number reflecting their age.

Gullane No. 1 (1884) has a long history of hosting national and international championship golf events, including the 2018 Aberdeen Standard Investments Scottish Open and Ladies Scottish Open, the Aberdeen Asset Management Scottish Open in 2015 as well as Local Final Qualifying for the Open Championship at neighbouring Muirfield.

Gullane No. 2 (1898) was laid out by the legendary Willie Park Jr and has also been used for Open Championship Qualifying as well as the Seniors Open Amateur.

Gullane No. 3 (1910) was also designed by Willie Park Jr. It may be the shortest of the three courses, but it provides a wonderful test based on shot-making skills rather than power.

Gullane offers a unique range of golfing experiences for members and visitors alike, combining a major role in the history of golf in Scotland, great golfing conditions, and a truly spectacular environment.
