Emma is a former Scotland Internationalist, winning the East Lothian Ladies County Championship in her final year as an Amateur. Emma turned professional in September 2010 after gaining her Honours degree in Applied Sports Science from The University of Edinburgh.

During her four years at University as an R&A golf scholar, she won the Scottish Universities Order of Merit and represented GB&I in The World University Games in Bangkok. Having been heavily involved in SLGA national training programs and representing Scotland in her years as a junior, Emma now competes at a high level on the PGA Tartan Tour and WPGA Tour around the UK, gaining invaluable experience in the Professional game.

Using her diverse knowledge of sport science disciplines including psychology, biomechanics, nutrition, physiology and physiotherapy combined with technical models of the golf swing, Emma aims to help players achieve their full potential as the 'complete' golfer.
